



ICM Qualifications - Tuition & Fees 2011 - 2012

There are two main qualifications:

- *ICM Diploma in Credit Management - Level 3*
- *ICM Diploma in Credit Management - Level 5*

Both Levels are individually examined.

The qualifications are highly regarded by the industry and provide opportunities to specialise and develop qualities that could be applied to other managerial roles.

The ICM level 5 Diploma in Credit Management provides a progression route to high level qualification such as MBA degree courses.

Where to study?

MACM Training Centre, 86/2, Triq ta' Mellu, Mosta is the accredited ICM Training Centre for Malta.

Part-time courses run at MACM in the evening (5:30pm – 7:30pm). Next intake will commence in **August / September 2011**, at MACM – Mosta. Prospective students are to register at MACM by not later than **23rd September 2011**.

Benefits to Students:

Examinations:

Examinations are held three times a year in **January, June and October**.

Accreditation:

The ICM is the only recognised body by the Qualifications and Curriculum Authority (QCA) of the UK to award qualifications in credit management.

Registration:

To ensure individual attention, the maximum number of students in each group is limited to 25 participants only. Since the number of participants is limited, it is recommended that those who are interested in the course are to register at MACM at their earliest – Registrations are processed on first-come-first-served basis and opens on **8th August 2011**. *MACM reserves the right not to run tuition classes for any subject if there are insufficient registrations, in which case the student will be informed and payment will be refunded in full.*

On the successful completion of the ICM Diploma in Credit Management Level 3, you will be eligible to become an Associate of the Institute of Credit Management (UK) and to use designatory letters AICM

Completion of the Diploma in Credit Management Level 5, entitles you to become a Graduate of the Institute of Credit Management (UK) and use the designatory letters MICM(Grad)

Course Fees:

Course Fees include 30 hours tuition per subject

(For students reading Assignment-based Units, 8 hours Tuition and individual supervision will be provided)

The ICM Diploma Level 3 Course Fees:

€200.00 + 18% VAT per subject for MACM Members' employees.

€250.00 + 18% VAT per subject for other students.

€175.00 + 18% VAT per Assignment-based Units.

The ICM Diploma Level 5 Course Fee:

€220.00 + 18% VAT per subject.

- Course fees do not include the ICM registration fee and textbooks.
- Maltese students studying through the Malta Centre are to register with the ICM through the Malta Association of Credit Management.
