Josef Busuttil, Director General of the Malta Association of Credit Management (MACM), participated in the **FENCA World Congress in Madrid** – FENCA is the Federation of European National Collection Associations, consisting of twenty-one National Associations from all over Europe. Every four years, FENCA organises its world renowned World Congress and this year's event attracted delegates from fifty-eight countries, covering all continents.

During his presentation, Josef Busuttil addressed 'The needs of the credit manager when hiring a collection agency'.
